When there is conflict in a group or family, the problem can be identified as either a relationship problem or a training problem. The solution is found when the adults take the time to invest in enhancing the relationship or supporting and fostering independence in the child so that they are able to master new social, self or life skills. The two day workshop with Vicki Hoefle offers parents, caregivers, and educators the opportunity to understand:

1. The role they play in the conflict and alternative ways to interact with children to get more desirable results;
2. How to help the child become more self-aware so they are able to make thoughtful, healthy choices;
3. How to meet the child where he is and support emotional growth and mastery of self, home, social and life skills;
4. How to build encouraging environments to facilitate long-term, sustainable change
