Understanding and Responding to the Sexual Behavior of Children & Adolescents is the first in a series of 3 trainings offered by PCAV. Created by Gail Ryan of the Kempe Children's Center, URSBC is designed to promote adult understanding of children's sexual behavior, as well as teach appropriate adult responses in order to intervene earlier in the development of sexually abusive patterns. The training is particularly relevant for professionals who interact directly with children, those who advise parents in regards to their children, and caregivers of children known to be at risk of sexual behavior problems.

Participants will learn to:

- Distinguish between normal, problematic and abusive behaviors;
- Develop universal goals to promote health and prevent perpetration of abuse;
- Intervene to prevent reinforcement of chronic abusive acting out.
